Editorial

"YOUNG PEOPLE BUILDERS OF PEACE"

"The Pulwama attack on February 14 was the deadliest attack to date on security forces in Kashmir". Adil Ahmed Dar the suicide bomber was an young man who used his energy to destruction. He was trained for a considerable length of time also it entailed a great deal of psychological training. If channelized the energy and abilities he could have been a wonderful person in life.

Around the world today, more and more societies are recognizing the role that youth play as agents of change and as critical actors in preventing conflict and building peace. In today's world 1.2 billion young people are affected by the horrors of conflict and war. We have come to realize that lasting peace cannot be built without both adequate protection of youth, as well as their engagement as stakeholders, provided impetus for the youth, peace and security agenda in recent years. Youth, peace and security mark a shift in the understanding of young people's roles in the larger context of peace building and post-conflict reconciliation. All young people are worthy of trust, even those who in our eyes, seem distant, indifferent, resistant to any kind of proposal. In the heart of every young person there is always a chord to make vibrate, a point accessible to the good. This is true for today as well. Pope Francis stresses that many young people, even though belonging to the generation of the 'selfie' or to a culture that more than 'fluid', seems 'gaseous', seek full meaning for their life, even if at times they do not look for it where they can find it. It is precisely among the young that we must express, an irreplaceable attitude. "Stay awake to awaken young people, be other centered in order to help young people to centre themselves in God". Let our involvement to infuse their hearts a desire to promote peace and thus becoming "builders of peace"!

Auxilium Navajeevana is a haven for "young girls who are at Risk". They are orphans, homeless, and have nowhere to go. They are at an young age shattered due to homelessness and missing care of responsible parenthood. Navajeevana takes care, protect, feed and educate them. Here the girls grow steadily learning how to bring peace within themselves and around them. They are intelligent and talented. Motivated they go ahead to build a peaceful environment and thus a society. Let us become partners with our endeavor to educate these young girls who will become assets to the nation!

"Young men and women are not passive beneficiaries, but equal and effective partners. Their aspirations extend far beyond jobs; youth also want a seat at the table — a real voice in shaping the policies that shape their lives. We need to listen to and engage with young people. We need to establish more and stronger mechanisms for youth participation. The time has come to integrate youth voices more meaningfully into decision-making processes at all levels".

happiness and received the blessings of the Lord and good wishes from the leaders, staffs and sisters.




LIFE SKILL




Children's day Celebration


